If the rule is in BLACK text, then it is the same as 2022.

If the rule is in **BLUE** text, then it has been changed for 2023.

If any future revisions are made it will be in RED text.

Crossover Classes

Class Designation: A/M

General Safety: All vehicles must conform with general WDRA safety rules.

Beam Tripper: A front beam tripper is permitted but can only extend 45" forward of the centerline of the front wheel.

Engine Coolant: Only water is permitted in the coolant system. Antifreeze or other additives are prohibited.

Hybrids: Import engines in Domestic bodies or Domestic engines in Import bodies are prohibited. All cars must be either Import bodied/powered or Domestic bodied/powered.

Crossover Rules: The crossover classes below run under their own set of class rules and ignore the WCF rulebook. You must be legal with your rulebook unless there is as a parity adjustment in the table below. In some cases, a crossover class may need an adjustment to be sped up or slowed down to make parity at WCF. If your car fits multiple crossover classes, then choose the one gives you the most advantage.

Fuel: Nitromethane or any other oxygenates cannot be injected, sprayed, leaked, or find its way into the engine in any way. Any cheating in any way will result in the racer being permanently banned from the event and the public will be informed of which racer was cheating. (Revised 10-27-23)

Oil: We will be taking oil samples from racers during the event in this class and sending them out to a lab for post event testing. Drivers must claim which oil they are using in their engine, and you must use it the way it came from the oil manufacturer. Nitromethane or any other oxygenates that aid in combustion are prohibited in engine oil. If a racer's oil is found to be illegal in post event lab testing, then the racer will be permanently banned from the event and the public will be informed of which racer was cheating. (Revised 10-27-23)

Fuel System: Only 1 fuel system is permitted and all cars that require a fuel check must be equipped with 2 fuel sample valves (1 on the fuel rail inlet and 1 on the fuel rail outlet).

Body Component Exemption: In an effort to allow crossover cars to get to a lower minimum weight if the crossover rules allow you to run lighter than your normal weight, all crossover class racers can run any light weight body components even if your sanctioning body does not allow it.

Towing Rule: Car must be driven to the scale after each pass. Towing is permitted from the scale to the pit area on every pass. A broken car can be towed to the scales after a pass with tech supervision only.
